## His Eyes Ministry College Project Honduras May 6-14, 2013

## honduras

For the last 19 years, Sherwood Oaks Christian Church has been involved with HIS EYES ministry in Tegucigalpa, Honduras, and with F.A.M.E. (Fellowship of Associates of Medical Evangelists), who resources the medical, dental, and optometry clinic on property. As a result of years of dedicated work, HIS EYES established mission churches in the villages of Choloteca, and San Juancito, Honduras.

Sherwood Oaks involvement has been to provide start-up and operational contributions, and to support teams and individuals who have traveled to Honduras over



the years to encourage and help meet the needs of our brothers and sisters there.

Honduras is one of the poorest countries in this hemisphere and the expression of God's love by meeting physical needs has drawn many to the Lord. It goes without saying that our primary goal is to glorify God by encouraging the Christian body there and by reaching out to the lost.

Sherwood Oaks has a strong commitment to HIS EYES ministry. Our resources, ministry teams, and prayers are important elements in our (SOCC) and HIS EYES development as growing members of the Body of Christ.

## specifics

**DATES:** May 6-14, 2013

**EYE CLINICS:** The team may conduct eye exams and provide eyeglasses to those in need. All training will be given before the team leaves for Honduras.

**CONSTRUCTION:** New construction and improvements on family homes, church or clinic facilities.

**FOOD DISTRIBUTION:** Food is purchased in markets, divided up and distributed to needy families in outlying areas.

**CLOTHING DISTRIBUTION:** A central distribution location is designated and donated clothing and shoes are distributed to the needy.

**TEAM:** 20 college student volunteers. Only criteria is a desire and willingness to serve the Lord and others in whatever way necessary. The ability to be flexible and patient is a BIG plus.

**TRAVEL:** Air travel from Indy to Tegucigalpa.

**FOOD & LODGING:** Mostly Honduran fare, prepared by Honduran cooks (similar to Mexican food minus the hot chili peppers). The team will stay in the Mission Guest House above the clinic.

**R&R:** The team will take some time for sight seeing, to be refreshed spiritually, and to build relationships with God's family there.

**Cost:** \$1,250. Includes airfare, food, lodging, transportation and insurance. Additional personal funds as desired for extras.

**FUNDRAISERS:** Fundraising letters to send to your family & friends are available through SOCC.

**DOCUMENTS:** A valid US Passport is necessary to enter Guatemala and reenter the US. Passport applications are available at any US Post Office. The cost is \$100 plus photo charge and the process takes 4 to 6 weeks.
